By Direction of the Surrogate:

In compliance with Office for Justice Initiatives goal to help bridge the digital divide by providing remote access to courts in safe, convenient community locations, and the court having determined that personal service of citation is impracticable in these proceedings, pursuant to its authority under Surrogate Court Procedure Act § 307(3), the court directs that all those cited in this proceeding be served by an alternative method of service of process.

Therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED, that the petitioner will serve the citation and the Richmond County Surrogate's Court Notice for Cited Parties, on all parties named in the citation and on any attorney who has appeared to date, regardless of their status as domiciliaries or natural persons, not less than twenty (20) days before the citation return date, by USPS Express Mail (otherwise known as Priority Mail), Certified Mail or Registered Mail, or any form of special delivery service set forth in SCPA 103 (35-a), 103(36), and 103(37-a), except that mailings that request return receipts shall not be allowed; and it is further

ORDERED, that proof of service shall consist of an affidavit of mailing that includes tracking numbers and proof of delivery of this Order, the Citation and the Richmond County Surrogate's Court Notice for Cited Parties, along with any other necessary documents (e.g., the will, the account summary), which shall be filed with the court on or before the second day preceding the return date, in accordance with 22 NYCRR 207.7(c); and it is further

ORDERED, that appearances on the return date of the citation will occur by video conference utilizing the Microsoft Teams application, which video link or dial-in information will be found in the citation.
