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WHEREFORE, defendant McCord Corporation, requests summary judgment in the above-captioned action, pursuant to Civil Practice Law and Rules Section 3212, dismissing the complaint and cross-claims against McCord Corporation, with prejudice, and after notice to all co-defendants there is no opposition, it is

ORDERED that all claims and cross-claims against defendant McCord Corporation are dismissed with prejudice and without costs.
