**MOTION REQUIREMENTS
HON. ANTHONY J. PARIS**

A personal appearance is required for all motions on the scheduled return date at 10:00 a.m. unless permission has been granted directly from Chambers to submit on papers.

Absent prior permission of Chambers, all motions must be filed and served a minimum of 28 days before oral argument and opposing papers and any cross-motions must be filed and served a minimum of 14 days before oral argument. Papers in opposition to any cross-motions are due seven days before oral arguments. Reply papers, if any, are to be limited to the issues raised in the opposition papers are due seven days before oral arguments.

Hard copies are to be delivered to Chambers within 24 hours of any e-filing.

PAPERS NOT TIMELY FILED WILL BE REJECTED.

Any attorney or litigant requesting an adjournment must request the same in writing, upon consent of all attorneys or litigants, to Hon. Anthony J. Paris, Onondaga County Courthouse, 401 Montgomery Street, Room 403, Syracuse, NY 13202.

Please note that pursuant to Judge Paris' e-file rules (posted on the Court's website), **you are required to send a hard copy of any/all documents that are e-filed** to Hon. Anthony J. Paris, 401 Montgomery Street, Suite 403, Syracuse, NY 13202 within 2 hours of the e-filing. No other courtesy copies are necessary or will be accepted.
