## PROCEDURE FOR REQUEST TO TRANSFER CASES TO SUPERIOR COURT FOR DRUG TREATMENT FROM CITY/TOWN/VILLAGE COURTS IN CORTLAND COUNTY

- 1. If a defendant is to be considered for entry into the Superior Court for Drug Treatment, the attorney for the defendant should contact Julie Nedza and request that she assess the defendant as to their eligibility/appropriateness for drug treatment court. Julie will also consult with the drug treatment court team regarding the defendant's eligibility.
- 2. If the District Attorney's Office and the defense attorney reach a plea agreement that includes the defendant's entry into drug treatment court, then the defense attorney shall file a motion with the local court where the case is pending asking that the local court grant an order transferring copies of the documents in the proceeding to the Superior Court for Drug Treatment (which is Cortland County Court). Attached are forms that may be used for this motion.
- 3. The local court may grant this motion, but is not required to.
- 4. If the local court grants the motion, then the local court judge needs to transfer copies of the papers and documents in the proceeding to the Superior Court for Drug Treatment (i.e., County Court).
- 5. Once received by the County Court Clerk, the papers sent by the local court shall be presented to the Hon. Elizabeth A. Burns for consideration.
- 6. Within 5 days Judge Burns will make a determination as to whether or not the case will be transferred to the Superior Court for Drug Treatment.
- 7. If Judge Burns determines that the case should be transferred, the court will enter an order and send it to the local court who will then transfer all original documents in the proceeding to the Superior Court for Drug Treatment, 46 Greenbush Street, Suite 31, Cortland, New York 13045. All future proceedings will be conducted in the Superior Court for Drug Treatment.
- 8. If Judge Burns determines that the case should not be transferred, the court will issue an order and the case will remain in the local court for proceedings in accordance with the law.
