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## Administrative Order:

By letter dated June 2, 2017, counsel for the defendants timely requests that this action be transferred into the Commercial Division pursuant to Commercial Division Rule 202.70 (e). Plaintiff's counsel does not object to the request.

Actions in which the principal claims are for breach of contract or business torts, where the breach or violation is alleged to arise out of business dealings, may be heard in the Commercial Division, provided the \$500,000 monetary threshold for New York County is met or equitable or declaratory relief is sought (Commercial Division Rule 202.70 [a], [b] [1]). The complaint alleges claims of fraud, breach of fiduciary duty, and, inter alia, unjust enrichment arising out of plaintiff's \$17 million investment in a Cayman Islands hedge fund.

Accordingly, the request for a transfer to the Commercial Division is granted. The General Clerk's Office is directed to randomly reassign this case from I.A.S. Part 7 (Lebovits, J.) to a Justice of the Commercial Division. (A motion to dismiss the complaint is currently returnable in the Motion Submissions Part on June 23, 2017.)
