By letter dated May 13, 2019, Theodore R. Snyder, Esq., counsel for respondent, requests that this proceeding be assigned to the Commercial Division pursuant to Uniform Rule 202.70. Counsel represents that petitioner's counsel does not object to this application.

The underlying arbitration before FINRA concerns petitioner's claims of breach of contract and breach of fiduciary against the respondent brokerage firm in amounts far exceeding \$500,000. The arbitration resulted in an award in respondent's favor. Petitioner commenced the instant proceeding seeking to disaffirm and vacate the arbitration award on May 3, 2019 by filing a notice of petition and petition and an RJI. Petitioner did not file a Commercial Division addendum and consequently the proceeding was assigned to a General Part (Hon. Lynn Kotler).
