Qualified applicants should submit application materials according to the directions listed on the court's website. Complete applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis and applicants who receive an interview will be asked to complete a writing test. Interested law clerk applicants are strongly encouraged to submit applications at any time even if a position is not currently available or listed on the court website. This court will keep your resume on file in the event there is an available position. Additionally, the Justices of the Commercial Division confer regularly and your application may be forwarded to another Justice.
