
Administrative Order:

By letter dated September 29, 2016, counsel for defendant and counterclaim-plaintiff Workspace, Inc. requests assignment of this action to the Commercial Division. The court has received no response to the request.

This action meets the standards for assignment to the Commercial Division pursuant to Uniform Rule 202.70 (b) (1). The \$500,000 monetary threshold for New York County is met by the ad damnum clause of the counterclaims.

Accordingly, the request for assignment to the Commercial Division is granted. The General Clerk's Office is directed to re-assign this case at random to a Justice of the Commercial Division. However, if the newly-assigned Commercial Division Justice finds, after further inquiry, that the actual amount in controversy is less than \$500,000 (see Verified Answer & Counterclaims, ¶ 57), he or she may transfer this action back to Part 58 (Cohen, J.) in accordance with Uniform Rule 202.70 (f) (1).
