## STREET ACTIVITY PERMITS

BY THE POWER VESTED IN ME AS MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1. Delegation of Functions, Powers and Duties Respecting Street Activity Permits.** Pursuant to subdivision f of section 8 of the New York City Charter, the Community Assistance Unit, acting through its Street Activity Permit Office, is delegated the authority to exercise all functions, powers and duties regarding the issuance of street activity permits and assessment of fees for street festivals, parties, celebrations, fairs and other events previously authorized to be performed by the Community Assistance Unit by Board of Estimate Resolution Cal. No. 47, dated July 17, 1980.

**§2. Review and Approval Procedures.** Pursuant to section 1142 of the New York City Charter, the rules entitled "Street Activity Permit Office Procedures For the Submission and Review of Applications for Street Activity Permits and Establishment of a Uniform Scale of Fees and Charges for Street Activities", made effective February 2, 1981 and amended as of June 4, 1990, are continued in effect.

§3. This Order shall take effect immediately.
