## **MEDIA ACCESS: PSNY v DONALD J. TRUMP**

### *Indictment 71543-2023*

**Date:** Monday, April 15, 2024—Jury selection followed by trial

**Location:** NY County Supreme Court, 100 Centre St., Criminal Term, Part 59, Room 1530 (15th Floor)

**Overflow Courtroom:** Room 1523 (with closed-circuit AV feed, for press and public)

**Time Courtroom Opens:** 9:30 am

**Duration of Proceeding:** Approximately six to eight weeks; weekdays excluding Wednesdays

**Press Arrival Outside Courthouse:** By 7:00-7:45 am

**Trial Seating:** For Courtroom 1530, a Press-Organized list of reserve seats for approx. 58 journalists with OCA oversight. For Overflow Room 1523, approx. 114 seats total

**Jury Selection Seating:** For Courtroom 1530, a Press-Organized pool of 6 journalists and one courtroom sketch artist. No sketches of jurors allowed. For Overflow Room 1523, the Press-Organized list of reserved seats for approx. 58 journalists will apply, with OCA oversight; remaining seats will be first come.

**For duration of proceedings:**

- Rooms 1530 and 1523 will allow controlled exit for bathroom, etc. Exit of building will be via north elevators and subject to rescreening upon reentry.
- One seat per outlet
- For Pool and Reserved Seats: Arrive 7:50 am
- For balance of seats in Room 1523: First come with 2 lines outside—a first line for Secure Pass holders; a second line for Credentialed Press without Secure Pass ID.

**Stills/Video:** Press-selected rotating pool of 5 still photographers in 15th Fl. Hallway pen; one Press-selected 3-person pool video team, to rotate. Arrive 7:50 am

- The 5-person pool of still photojournalists will be permitted to take photographs from the well before the commencement of the proceedings. (Continuance of prior decision)
- Present in Hallway Pen will be Press-selected pool of 3 pen-and-paper print journalists, with no camera or video recording purpose; audio recording allowed for accuracy and reporting purpose—but no broadcast (STRICTLY ENFORCED); can move between Room 1523 and Pen when court is in session.

**Rules:**

- Press with approved credentials can use laptops inside Room 1530 and Room 1523
- No cell phone use, no video, no photographs, no audio recording (STRICTLY ENFORCED); journalists may pack lunch—but no glass containers allowed and no eating in Rooms 1523 and 1530 (STRICTLY ENFORCED)
- Cell phones can be used in Room 1523 ONLY for texting and/or as a hot spot
- Entire 15th Floor will be closed for lunch
- First Floor Press Room and all other floors will remain open throughout—as always
