Appellate Division, Third Dept. to Hold Session in Chenango County

ALBANY, NEW YORK—The New York State Supreme Court, Appellate Division, Third Judicial Department—a mid-level appellate court based in Albany—will hold a session at the Chenango County Courthouse in Norwich, New York on Friday, November 17, 2023 at 10:00 a.m. This will be the second time the Third Department conducts a regular session of Court in Chenango County. The Court last sat in Chenango County Court in May 1998.

The five-judge panel will include Presiding Justice Elizabeth A. Garry, Justice John C. Egan, Jr., Justice Sharon A.M. Aarons, Justice Stan L. Pritzker, and Justice Molly Reynolds Fitzgerald. Students from several schools in the local area will be in attendance and have an opportunity to meet with the judges.

The session will be followed by a ceremony, featuring the unveiling of a portrait of Presiding Justice Elizabeth Garry. The portrait will be displayed at the Chenango County Courthouse in Norwich, where Justice Garry began her legal career as a confidential law clerk to Hon. Irad S. Ingraham in 1990 and later served for more than 16 years as a Supreme Court Justice, then as an Associate Justice and later as Presiding Justice of the Appellate Division, Third Department.

The Appellate Division, Third Department, hears appeals from all trial-level courts in the 28 counties within the Court's geographical jurisdiction, which includes the following counties: Albany, Columbia, Greene, Rensselaer, Schoharie, Sullivan and Ulster in the Third Judicial District; Clinton, Essex, Franklin, Fulton, Hamilton, Montgomery, St. Lawrence, Saratoga, Schenectady, Warren and Washington in the Fourth Judicial District; and Broome, Chemung, Chenango, Cortland, Delaware, Madison, Otsego, Schuyler, Tompkins and Tioga in the Sixth Judicial District.
