Diane Mole-Blaha, being duly sworn, deposes and says:


1. I am a Senior Court Analyst for the Office of Court Administration Attorney Registration Unit ("OCA") and am responsible for, and oversee, the registration of attorneys admitted to the New York State Bar, including the OCA Attorney Services - Registration Database.

2. As Senior Court Analyst I oversaw the compilation of a list of attorneys who have not re-registered with OCA during the 2016-17 and 2017-18 biennial registration periods. The list included the names of those attorneys whose business address is in the Third Judicial Department, or if the attorneys' last address was outside of New York State, the department of admission, which was the Third Judicial Department.

3. In an effort to contact the attorneys on the list (Exhibits "A", "B", and "C" herein) who were required to re-register for each biennial period, a first notice to re-register was sent to each attorney at their home address the month just before their birth.

4. A second notice was sent to the attorney's business address requesting registration compliance, and a third and final notice was sent to the attorney's home address directing the attorney to register. Additionally, most of the attorneys on the list were sent a Delinquent Notice detailing each past-due registration.

5. Despite the mailing of the above notices, the attorneys listed on **Exhibits "A", "B", and "C"**, remain unregistered according to the records of OCA.
