Answer: Hi Floyd, I'm not sure which forms this is, but on my end, for storage purposes, UCS 140 we'll need them in 100M shipments, four times a year.

Question: Floyd Stewart Can you please advise me if the stub on form UF 135 is on the 5-1/2 or 8-1/2 side. Can you also tell the number of locations these forms will be shipped to and if possible the approx amount per shipment

Answer: This is in response to your email to Floyd Stewart. I'm not sure what you mean by "stub", if it pertains to where I want the padding, then the 5 1/2 side would be fine. The form UF 135 should be sent to one location to my attention: 25 Beaver Street, 8th floor Storage, New York, NY 10004, in increments of 100M per quarter (I assume 400M was ordered). If not, please advise of the quantity ordered since storage here is limited. If you require any further information, you can email me directly.

Question: Could you please mail me a sample of carbonless from under bid # OCA/CA-123. And it had 2 type of NCR paper one is call NCR Superior product does not contain any recycled content and the other call NCR Recover product which is Produced with 50% waste paper, 30% Post Consumer waste but is need time to custom make. Please let me know which I have to base on is bid. Thank you so much.

Question: In regards to printing of carbonless forms, when I looked in archives on line the last time I seen they were bid on was in 03. Could you tell me if that is so.
