She is responsible for the daily management of the shelter, for the related civil legal issues of shelter victims, and for the development of the Center. Joy is an active participant in the New York State Summits on Elder Abuse, a member of numerous state and local coalitions and boards, and is a partner in the creation of the New York City Elder Abuse Center. She has testified as an expert for the United States Senate Special Committee on Elder Abuse and is a frequent speaker and writer on issues of elder abuse and mistreatment.
