

## Centralized Motion Part Notice

Administrative Justice Jeremy S. Weinstein has announced that Queens Supreme Court, Civil Term, is establishing a Centralized Motion Part (CMP) effective **October 1, 2012**. The CMP calendar will be called at 2:15 PM in Courtroom 25 located at 88-11 Sutphin Blvd., Jamaica, NY 11435. **(See information below pertaining to notices of motion returnable on Fridays)**

Excluded from the CMP will be applications involving Article 81 proceedings, Matrimonial matters, Election Law proceedings, Tax Certiorari proceedings, Unsafe Building proceedings, Nuisance Abatement proceedings, Uninsured Motor Vehicle proceedings, Condemnation proceedings and all Medical Malpractice proceedings assigned to Judge O'Donoghue. Applications in these proceedings will be processed under their current system.

Any application noticed prior to and including **September 30, 2012**, will be processed under the current system scheduling the application before the IAS Justice, and will remain with the IAS Justice, including those scheduled for a future date, until resolution.

Any application noticed for and after **October 1, 2012**, **MUST** be noticed to be heard at 2:15 PM in the Centralized Motion Part, Courtroom 25, located at 88-11 Sutphin Blvd., Jamaica, NY 11435. **(See information below pertaining to notices of motion returnable on Fridays)**

All noticed applications **MUST** be fee processed by the County Clerk and in the possession of the Motion Support Office a minimum of five business days in advance of the return date. The application will appear on the CMP calendar on the date in the notice except when the court will be compelled to administratively reschedule in the following situations:

- Any application noticed for a holiday
- Any application noticed for a Saturday or a Sunday
- Any application filed untimely as mentioned above
- Any matter in which Corporation Counsel appears ( motions must be noticed for a Tuesday or Wednesday)

Should the court administratively reschedule, the movant will be responsible for notifying all parties of the administratively rescheduled date which can be ascertained at the e-court's web site at <http://iapps.courts.state.ny.us/webcivil/ecourtsMain>. Additionally, please be advised that a working copy of all e-filed papers must be submitted during the call of the calendar.
