ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

By the authority vested in me as Administrative Judge of the Supreme Court, Civil Branch, New York County, in light of the Decision and Order of the Litigation Coordinating Panel of the State of New York (“the Panel”) in Luciere v. Bristol-Myers Squibb, Panel Case No. 0012/2011, dated January 24, 2012, and pursuant to Section 202.69 (c) (1) of the Uniform Rules for the Trial Courts,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The Panel having directed the coordination pursuant to Section 202.69 of the Luciere action, the other actions listed in the appendix hereto, and any other action now pending or hereafter commenced in which the plaintiff seeks damages for injuries sustained from ingestion of the drug Plavix (“Plavix actions”) and having directed that the coordination take place in Supreme Court, Civil Branch, New York County before a Coordinating Justice of that county, Justice Marcy S. Friedman, a Justice of the Center for Complex Litigation of this court, is hereby designated to serve as Coordinating Justice for the coordination of the Plavix actions.

2. The Clerk is directed to reassign or assign, as the case may be, to Justice Friedman, for the purpose of the coordination and all purposes, all Plavix actions commenced in this court in which a Request for Judicial Intervention (“RJI”) has been filed and processed or in which the RJI is filed or processed hereafter. The Clerk is further directed to assign to Justice Friedman, for the purpose of the coordination, all Plavix actions that are, at any time hereafter, transferred to this court from any other court pursuant to the Decision and Order of the Panel.

3. In cases that are transferred to this court from another for the purpose of coordination, the Clerk of this court shall assign a New York County index number without fee to facilitate efficient processing of the case. An RJI shall be filed promptly in every case covered by this Order in which an RJI has not yet been filed. An RJI shall be filed if one was not previously filed in this court and the Clerk shall process the RJI without imposing a fee if the party has already paid the relevant fee in another county. Attorneys who hereafter file any Plavix action in this court or effect transfer of any such matter to this court for coordination as directed by the Panel in the Decision and Order set forth above shall identify on the RJI the kind of case involved (Plavix Action) and shall attach to the

RJI a copy of this Administrative Order.

4. It appears that utilization of the New York State Courts Electronic Filing System (“NYSCEF”) would be appropriate and beneficial for the parties in these cases and for the court. Counsel may obtain information on the NYSCEF website (www.nycourts.gov/efile). Live training is available for those who may feel the need for it. A two-hour training course is offered weekly, with two CLE credits awarded to attending counsel at no charge, at Supreme Court, Civil Branch, New York County at 60 Centre Street. Attorneys must register in advance for this course, which may be done on-line at the “Training” link on the NYSCEF website. For additional information, counsel should contact the statewide NYSCEF Resource Center at 646-386-3033 or efile@courts.state.ny.us.

5. Counsel should be aware that orders in various mass tort actions in this court, including initial case management orders setting forth procedures for a master caption and index number and similar matters, are posted on the court’s website (at the link “Mass Tort Orders” at www.nycourts.gov/suptmanh).
