

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING OUT THE
PETITION FOR THE PARTIAL WITHDRAWAL OF AN INFANT'S FUNDS

PRINT AND USE BLACK INK ONLY.

- 1 Name of the county where you are going to file the petition.
- 2 Leave Blank.
- 3 Write the name of the Plaintiff(s)/Petitioner(s). If you are the Plaintiff, enter your name here.
- 4 Write the name of the Defendant(s)/Respondent(s).
- 5 Write your case Index Number.
- 6 Name of the county where you are going to file the petition.
- 7 Write the name of the Plaintiff(s)/Petitioner(s).
- 8 Write infant's name.
- 9 Write the current age of the infant.
- 10 Enter the infant's date of birth.
- 11 Enter the address where the infant resides.
- 12 Insert amount of original deposit.
- 13 Insert date original deposit was made.
- 14 Insert amount of settlement awarded to petitioner for loss of services, if any.
- 15 Enter date, amount, and reason for any prior withdrawals from infant's funds.
- 16 Enter the amount currently in the account.
- 17 Enter the amount being requested for withdrawal.
- 18 Describe how the funds will be used if the withdrawal is approved. Be as specific as possible.
- 19 Enter the number of people living in the household.

- 20 Enter the name, relationship to the infant, and age of all those residing in the household.
- 21 If the residence is rented, enter the monthly rent amount. If Petitioner owns the home, enter zero.
- 22 If the residence is owned, enter the monthly mortgage and any other related fixed charges.
- 23 Enter the income of those residing in the household.
- 24 Circle one to indicate whether the family owns any real property.
- 25 Enter the total amount of any other bank deposits including brokerage and money market accounts.
- 26 Leave as written unless there has been a prior application. If a prior application has been made, delete the line "No prior applications for the relief..." and attach a separate sheet of paper explaining the outcome of the prior application.
- 27 Petitioner must sign the petition.
- 28 Petitioner must print his/her name.
- 29 Insert the county where the petition is notarized.
- 30 Print petitioner's name.
- 31 Petitioner must sign here in front of a notary public.
- 32 Petitioner must print his/her name in front of a notary public.
- 33 Leave blank - to be completed by the notary public.
