REQUIREMENTS FOR WITHDRAWAL OF INFANT'S FUNDS.

*****PLEASE NOTE: SUCH WITHDRAWALS GENERALLY CANNOT BE FOR THE CHILD'S NEEDS FOR WHICH THE GUARDIAN OR PARENT IS LEGALLY OBLIGATED TO PROVIDE (LIKE FOOD, CLOTHING, ETC.) AND CANNOT BE USED TO BUY THINGS FOR GUARDIAN OR PARENTAL USE (LIKE A NEW CAR).**

PETITION OF GUARDIAN SHOULD INCLUDE:

1. Age, and date of birth of Infant.
2. Residence of Infant.
3. If 14 years or over, **acknowledged consent to be affached.**
4. Attorney's fee asked, unless waived by affidavit.
5. Date of original deposit.
6. If recent compromise, amount received for loss of services; if none, "so state"
7. Dates and amounts of any prior withdrawals.
8. Amount now on deposit.
9. Amount of present requested withdrawal. (Attach Bills, estimates, etc.)
10. Purpose for which money is to be used.
11. Number of members in family.
12. Rent paid per month.
13. Occupation of Father and earnings, if any.

14. Occupation of Mother and earnings, if any.
15. Number of children in family.
16. Ages of children.
17. Occupation of children and income, if any.
18. State whether or not family has any real property or income therefrom.
19. Family income, if any, from sources other than earnings.
20. State whether or not any money in bank other than infants.
21. State if any previous application has been made for the relief requested. (CPLR 2217(b)).

Acknowledged Consent of Infant to Be Attached If The Infant Is 14 years Of Age Or Older.

Attach Statement From Bank(s) Showing The Amount Currently On Deposit.

Attach Original Infant Compromise Order (Judgment) (Copy Thereof).

Attach Most Recent Partial Withdrawal Of Infant's Funds Order (If Applicable).
