TRAINING FOR MANDATORY EFILING ERIE COUNTY SUPREME COURT

Chapter 184 of the laws of 2012 authorizes mandatory efilng in Erie County Supreme Court. We anticipate that New York's Chief Administrative Judge, A. Gail Prudenti, will soon issue an administrative order designating case types and effective dates for this mandatory program. The case types will include commercial and residential foreclosures, commercial actions, contract and tort actions, medical malpractice actions, asbestos matters and tax certiorari proceedings.

Initial training for attorneys and their staff members will be provided on March 7 at 10:00 a.m. and March 19 at 2:00 p.m. in the Ceremonial Courtroom on the second floor of the courthouse located in Erie County Hall at 92 Franklin Street, Buffalo, New York. Additional training will be offered in June and September. Attorneys and their staff members may attend either session, which is being provided free of charge, and attorney-participants will receive 2 CLE credits.
