Judgment, Supreme Court, New York County (Maxwell T. Wiley, J.), rendered July 26, 2023, convicting defendant, upon his plea of guilty, of custodial interference in the first degree, and sentencing him as a second felony offender to a term of two to four years of imprisonment, unanimously modified, as a matter of discretion in the interest of justice, to the extent of reducing the sentence of imprisonment to a term of **1 1/2 to 3** years, and otherwise affirmed.

We find the sentence excessive to the extent indicated.
