Administrative Order:

By letter dated June 2, 2008, plaintiffs' counsel seeks review of the order of the Hon. Helen Freedman dated May 23, 2008 transferring this action to a non-commercial part pursuant to Uniform Rule 202.70(f)(1). There is no opposition from any other party and the case is presently pending before the Hon. Marilyn Diamond (I.A.S. Part 48).

There is no question that this action falls within the standards for assignment to the Commercial Division. The complaint seeks damages in excess of \$1,000,000 and asserts claims of fraud, breach of contract and breach of fiduciary duty arising out of business dealings, namely the individual plaintiffs' investment in, and loans to, VMI Production, Inc. ("VMI"), a company they were allegedly told would organize, promote and market live entertainment events featuring mostly Russian entertainers in the United States and Canada. See Uniform Rule 202.70(b)(1).

Accordingly, the Trial Support Office is directed to reassign this case back to Justice Freedman (Part 39).
