INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE SERVICE OF AN IN PERSON (PRO SE) ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE AND VERIFIED PETITION (H.P.)

- 1. Once a Judge has signed an Order to *Show* Cause (OSC) you will either be given copies or be lent the originals and be told to make three copies.
- 2. The Clerk will keep the original Verified Petition and the Order to *Show* Cause, and will give you the copies. The copies are to be served (delivered) as follows:
 - a. The first set of copies goes to the landlord.
 - b. The second set of copies goes to the Department of Housing Preservation and Development (DHPD)
 - c. The third set of copies is your set.
- 3. The first set of copies of the Order to *Show* Cause and the Verified Petition must be served on the landlord as directed.

You may serve the Order to *Show* Cause and the Verified Petition by:

a. giving them to the respondent/landlord in person;

OR, IF PERMITTED BY THE JUDGE

- b. mailing them to the respondent/landlord by Certified Mail, Return Receipt Requested.
- 4. You must also mail the second set of copies of both the Order to *Show* Cause and the Verified Petition, by Certified Mail, Return Receipt Requested, to:

- 5. You must fill out an Affidavit *of* Service *of* Order to Show Cause and Verified Petition (CIV-LT-25), attach the Certified Mail receipt(s) to it, and sign it in front of either a Notary Public or the Clerk. You must bring the Affidavit *of* Service, with the receipt(s) attached, to the court on the date of the hearing.
- 6. Normally an inspection of your apartment will be scheduled by the Clerk. In some counties you will have to contact the inspector yourself. Ask the Clerk.
