Appeal by the defendant from a judgment of the County Court, Rockland County (Nelson, J.), rendered October 23, 2012, convicting him of attempted criminal possession of a forged instrument in the second degree, upon his plea of guilty, and imposing sentence.

ORDERED that the judgment is affirmed.

The defendant's valid waiver of his right to appeal (*see People v Sanders*, 25 NY3d 337, 341-342; *People v Lopez*, 6 NY3d 248, 256-257) precludes appellate review of his contention that the sentence imposed was excessive (*see People v Seaberg*, 74 NY2d 1, 9).
