Appeal by the defendant, as limited by his motion, from a sentence of the Supreme Court, Kings County (William Miller, J.), imposed July 13, 2016, upon his plea of guilty, on the ground that the sentence was excessive.

ORDERED that the sentence is affirmed.

The record demonstrates that the defendant knowingly, voluntarily, and intelligently waived his right to appeal (*see People v Sanders*, 25 NY3d 337, 341-342; *People v Ramos*, 7 NY3d 737, 738; *cf. People v Brown*, 122 AD3d 133, 145-146). The defendant's valid waiver of his right to appeal precludes review of his contention that the sentence imposed was excessive (*see People v Lopez*, 6 NY3d 248, 256).
