DECISION, ORDER & JUDGMENT

Writ of habeas corpus in the nature of an application to release the defendant on his
own recognizance or for bail reduction upon Richmond County Indictment No. 266/18.

ADJUDGED that the writ is sustained, without costs or disbursements, to the extent
that bail on Richmond County Indictment No. 266/18 is reduced to the sum of \$12,000, which may
be posted in the form of an insurance company bail bond in that sum or by depositing the sum of
\$1,200 as a cash bail alternative, and the writ is otherwise denied; and it is further,

ORDERED that upon receipt of a copy of this decision, order and judgment together
with proof that the defendant has given a bail bond in the sum of \$12,000 or has deposited \$1,200
as a cash bail alternative, the Warden of the facility at which the defendant is incarcerated, or his or
her agent, is directed to immediately release the defendant.
