Appeals by the defendant from two judgments of the Supreme Court, Queens County (Richard L. Buchter, J.), both rendered July 30, 2012, convicting him of identity theft in the first degree under Indictment No. 1767/11 and identity theft in the first degree under Indictment No. 1769/11, upon his pleas of guilty, and imposing sentences. Assigned counsel has submitted a brief in accordance with *Anders v California* (386 US 738), in which he moves for leave to withdraw as counsel for the appellant.

ORDERED that the judgments are affirmed.

We are satisfied with the sufficiency of the brief filed by the defendant's assigned counsel pursuant to *Anders v California* (386 US 738). Upon an independent review of the record, we conclude that there are no nonfrivolous issues which could be raised on the appeals. Counsel's application for leave to withdraw as counsel is, therefore, granted (*see id.*; *Matter of Giovanni S.*


