DECISION & ORDER ON MOTION

(S.C.I. No. 1664N/16)

Motion by the appellant's assigned counsel on an appeal from a judgment of the Supreme Court, Nassau County, rendered December 9, 2016, to be relieved of the assignment on the ground that the appellant has abandoned the appeal by failing to communicate with assigned counsel.
