DECISION & ORDER ON MOTION

(S.C.I. No. 684/15)

Motion by N. Scott Banks, counsel assigned to prosecute an appeal from a judgment of the County Court, Nassau County, rendered October 9, 2015, to be relieved on the ground that the appellant has abandoned the appeal by failing to respond to communications by assigned counsel. By order to show cause dated November 29, 2017, the appellant was directed to show cause before this Court why an order should or should not be made and entered dismissing the appeal on the ground that the appellant had abandoned the appeal, and assigned counsel's motion was held in abeyance in the interim.
