Amicus Curiae Participation

On May 12, 2009 the Court of Appeals granted leave to appeal in Portfolio Recovery Associates, LLC v Jared King, a collection action to recover a credit card balance, which raises, among other issues, whether New York's "borrowing statute," CPLR 202, applies and, if so, whether the action is untimely under the three-year Delaware statute of limitations (where the bank that issued the credit card was incorporated). The Appellate Division decision appears at 55 AD3d 1074, 866 NYS2d 395.

The Court invites amicus curiae participation from those qualified and interested.
