Administrative Order:

By letter dated June 9, 2008, counsel for plaintiff CPI NA Parnassus B.V. requests that this action be assigned to the Commercial Division pursuant to Uniform Rule 202.70. There is no opposition from defendant.

The matter falls clearly within the standards for assignment of cases to the Commercial Division in New York County. Plaintiff sues for damages in excess of \$57.9 million based on the defendant's alleged breach of a guaranty and loan agreement securing a loan to facilitate the construction and development of commercial real property in Cancun, Mexico. See Uniform Rule 202.70(b)(1).

Accordingly, plaintiff's request is granted. The Motion Support Office is directed to reassign this case at random from I.A.S. Part 17 (Goodman, J.) to a Justice of the Commercial Division. (A motion to dismiss the complaint is currently returnable in the Motion Submissions Part on June 20, 2008.)
