
By letter dated December 28, 2015, counsel for nominal defendant Bristol-Myers Squibb Company and certain of its officers and directors requests that this action be assigned to the Commercial Division pursuant to Uniform Rule 202.70. The court has received no other correspondence in regard to this matter.

This shareholder derivative action alleges breach of fiduciary duties by the defendants in the management of Bristol-Myers Squibb Company and seeks damages on behalf of the company well in excess of the \$500,000 monetary threshold for New York County as well as injunctive relief. Thus, it falls clearly within the standards for assignment of cases to the Commercial Division (see

Uniform Rule 202.70 [a], [b] [1], [4] and [7]).

The request for re-assignment is granted, and the General Clerk's Office is directed to re-assign this case from I.A.S. Part 46 (Billings, J.) to a Justice of the Commercial Division.
