
Administrative Order:

By letter dated January 16, 2015, plaintiffs' counsel requests that this action be transferred into the Commercial Division pursuant to Uniform Rule 202.70 (e). To date, no opposition has been received.

In this action, plaintiffs bring claims for breach of fiduciary duty, fraud, and breach contract stemming from a series of agreements in connection with the Bravo television show "the Real Housewives." Plaintiffs seek monetary damages exceeding \$5 million. Since the action meets the standards for assignment to the Commercial Division in this county (see Uniform Rule 202.70 [a], [b][1]), plaintiffs' request is granted.

The Trial Support Office is directed to randomly reassign this action from Part 58 (Mills, J.) to a Justice of the Commercial Division.
