Administrative Order:

By letter dated June 10, 2016 from defendants' counsel, the parties jointly request that this action be assigned to the Commercial Division pursuant to Uniform Rule 202.70 (e), and, in particular, to the Hon. Shirley Werner Kornreich as related to Rosenfeld Consulting LLC v OmniVere, LLC, et al., Index No. 651650/2015, and Balint v Kopy International, et al., Index No. 652230/2014 (the Kornreich Actions).

This action meets the standards for assignment to the Commercial Division, as it involves claims for fraud and breach of contract arising out of an asset purchase agreement under which plaintiff acquired almost all the assets of Intelligent Discovery Management, LLC and Balint Brown & Basri, LLC (Uniform Rule 202.70 [b] [1]). Plaintiff seeks over \$13 million in damages (Uniform Rule 202.70 [a]). The parties have entered into a stipulation asserting that this action is related to the Kornreich Actions. Accordingly, I am granting the request for assignment to the Commercial Division, but I am directing that this action be reassigned to Justice Kornreich for a determination as to whether this action is truly related (see Dec. 2011 Operations Manual, § [I] [D] [2]). If Justice Kornreich determines that the actions are not related, she may direct that this case be reassigned at random to another Commercial Division Part (*id.*).

The General Clerk's Office is directed to reassign this action from I.A.S. Part 17 (Hagler, J.) to Commercial Division Part 54 (Kornreich, J.).
