Administrative Order:

By letter dated December 5, 2011, counsel for nominal defendant Ralph Lauren Corporation timely requests that this action be re-assigned from I.A.S. Part 12 (Feinman, J.) to the Commercial Division pursuant to Uniform Rule 202.70. To date, no objection has been received.

This shareholder's derivative action alleges claims for breach of fiduciary duties, waste of corporate assets, and unjust enrichment all arising out of the parties' business dealings. Thus, it falls clearly within the standards for assignment of cases to the Commercial Division (see Uniform Rule 202.70[b][1], [4]). Further, as a shareholder's derivative action, it may be assigned to the Commercial Division without regard to the monetary threshold (see Uniform Rule 202.70[a], [b] [4]).

The request for re-assignment is granted, and the Trial Support Office is directed to re-assign this case at random to a Justice of the Commercial Division.
