

Administrative Order:

Uniform Rule 202.70(b) (1) provides that breach of contract actions arising out of business dealings, specifically referencing employment agreements, will be heard in the Commercial Division provided the \$500,000 monetary threshold for New York County is met or the action seeks declaratory or equitable relief. There is no question that the nature of the action makes it one that should be assigned to the Commercial Division, as the plaintiff's claims arise from the alleged breach of an employment agreement.

Accordingly, the Motion Support Office is directed to randomly reassign this case to the Commercial Division.
