Robert G. Bogle was appointed the Acting Village Justice of the Village of Valley Stream in 1986. In 1988 he was appointed as Village Justice and has been reelected six times since. He is the Acting City Court Judge for the City of Long Beach. He also serves as the Chief Court Attorney for the Department of Law of the Nassau County Court. The Department advises various County Court Judges, Administrators and Clerks on legal issues. He is an adjunct professor of criminal justice for graduate and undergraduate students at C.W. Post College of Long Island University. He was President of the New York State Magistrates Association, the State Organization of Town and Village Justices. He is a former President of the Nassau County Magistrates Association. He is a lecturer of the Judicial Education Program of the Office of Court Administration and a member of the Local Courts Advisory Committee. He is coauthor of "Village, Town and District Courts in New York," by Thomson/West. He is the Directing Editor of West's McKinney's Forms Criminal Procedure Law (four volumes) and the author of Criminal Procedure in New York (four volumes). He has previously served as Law Secretary to the Honorable Ira H. Wexner, Supervising Judge of the Nassau County District and County Courts, and as Deputy Nassau County Attorney for the Appeals and Major Litigation Bureau. He is a graduate of Niagara University (Cum Laude) and Hofstra University School of Law and attended Cornell University and George Washington University. He is active in his community as a member of various civic organizations. He lives in Valley Stream and is married to his wife, Kathleen, and has two sons.
