Executive Order No. 20

PAYMENT OF CLAIMS OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES

By the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of New York, it is hereby ordered:

Section 1. The Director of the Mayor's Office of Administrative Services is authorized to conduct all inquiries and hearings, make all determinations, and authorize all payments which may be conducted, made or authorized by the Mayor pursuant to section 12-104 of the Administrative Code in relation to any claims as described therein filed against the City, an agency of the City or the Board of Education, by duly appointed employees or their estates.

§2. This Order shall take effect immediately.
