Amendment of Executive Order No. 16  
(July 26, 1978)

By the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of New York, it is hereby ordered:

Section 1. **Prior Order Amended.** Paragraph (a) of Section 7 of prior Executive Order No. 16, dated July 26, 1978 is hereby amended to read as follows:

“§7. **Background Investigations.** (a) The Department of Investigation shall conduct background investigations of all persons to be appointed to or employed in positions with salary rates equal to or greater than the minimum rate of the Management Pay Plan or any successor plan, whether or not the person is to become a member of such plan. The Commissioner shall have the discretion to waive this requirement when he determines that the investigation is not necessary.”

Section 2. **Effective Date.** This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
