Upon the papers filed in support of the motion, and no papers having been filed in opposition thereto, it is

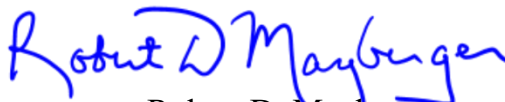

ORDERED that the motion for assignment of counsel is denied, without costs, and it is further

ORDERED that the motion for an extension of time to perfect the proceeding is granted, without costs, and the time is extended to July 14, 2026.
