Upon the papers filed in support of the motion and the papers filed in opposition thereto, it is

ORDERED that the motion is granted, without costs, only to the extent that those portions of Supreme Court's judgment, entered March 9, 2026, which directed the sale and distribution of marital real property and the equipment used by respondent-appellant's business are hereby stayed. The motion is otherwise denied and all other portions of the judgment remain in effect, including so much of the judgment as obligates respondent-appellant to pay weekly child support and child support arrears retroactive to the filing of the complaint.
