Motion for extension of time to perfect appeals and proceeding, for stay pending appeals and proceeding, to waive certification of record and for further relief.

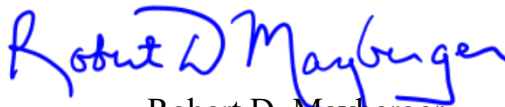
Upon the papers filed in support of the motion and the papers filed in opposition thereto, it is
