An order of this Court, having been entered on November 17, 2022 (Motion No. 2022-03603-319), suspending petitioner (who was admitted to practice as an attorney and counselor-at-law in the State of New York at a Term of the Appellate Division of the Supreme Court for the Second Judicial Department on May 6, 2009), effective immediately, and until further order of this court, for failure to file attorney registration statements and pay biennial registration fees in violation of Judiciary Law § 468-a,

And a corrected order of this Court, having been entered on March 13, 2026, granting the parties joint motion for discipline by consent, pursuant to 22 NYCRR 1240.8(a)(5), and imposed an eighteen-month suspension nunc pro tunc to October 14, 2024,

And petitioner, by his counsel, Tyler Maulsby, Esq., having moved this Court on April 24, 2026, for an order pursuant to NYCRR 1240.16(a) and (b), reinstating him as an attorney and counselor-at-law in the State of New York,

And the Lawyers' Fund for Client Protection having submitted a letter dated May 6, 2026, stating that they do not oppose petitioner's application,

And the AGC (Eric Sun, of counsel), having submitted an affirmation of no opposition dated May 27, 2026,

Now, upon reading and filing the papers with respect to the motion, and due deliberation having been had thereon, it is unanimously,

Ordered that the motion is granted, and petitioner is reinstated as an attorney and counselor-at-law in the State of New York, effective the date hereof. Petitioner is directed to immediately register with, and pay to, the Office of Court Administration any applicable registration fees in compliance with Judiciary Law § 468-a.
