DECISION AND ORDER
ON MOTION

Motion for permission to supplement record on appeal, to settle record and for further relief.

Motion to hold administrative dismissal in abeyance, for extension of time to perfect appeal and for further relief.

Upon the papers filed in support of the motions and the papers filed in response and in opposition thereto, it is

ORDERED that the motion to hold the administrative dismissal in abeyance and for an extension of time to perfect the appeal is granted, without costs, to the extent that the dismissal of the appeal is vacated (*see* 22 NYCRR 1250.10 [c]) and the time to perfect the appeal is extended to October 5, 2026, and it is further

ORDERED that the motions for permission to supplement the record on appeal and for further relief are denied, without costs.
