Defendant having moved for reargument of the order of this Court, entered on February 21, 2017 (Motion No. 6541), which denied defendant's motion for an order, pursuant to Judiciary Law 509(a), directing the Commissioner of Jurors of New York County to disclose, inter alia, the full contact information for all jurors who deliberated and reached a verdict in the trial of defendant, and for other relief,

Now, upon reading and filing the papers with respect to the motion, and due deliberation having been had thereon,

It is ordered that the motion is granted and, upon reargument, the Commissioner of Jurors is directed to furnish to the New York County District Attorney's office and to the counsel for defendant, Mark M. Baker, Esq, to the extent available, a list reflecting the names and contact information for the jurors who deliberated and reached a verdict in the criminal action entitled *People v Szymon Chodakowski*, which was tried in Supreme Court, New York County, under Ind. No. 2930/15, in 2016, within 30 days of the date hereof, and

It is further ordered that the District Attorney's Office and counsel for defendant shall keep the material received confidential and may only share the information with a professionally licensed investigator, should either the District Attorney's Office or counsel for defendant choose to hire one for the upcoming evidentiary hearing. The jurors' personal information cannot under any circumstances be shared with the defendant or any other party not granted explicit privilege as outlined above. The jurors' personal information cannot be copied or altered, and the information must be destroyed immediately after the subject evidentiary hearing, and

It is further ordered that the order of this Court entered on February 21, 2017 (Motion No. 6541) is hereby recalled and vacated.
