Lowenstein, Esq., 567 Sunset Drive, Woodmere, New York, 11598, Telephone No. 516-374-1962, as such counsel. The poor person relief previously granted is continued, and appellant's time in which to perfect the appeal is extended until 60 days from the date of this order or the receipt of the complete record, whichever is later, (M-2022-02881); and

It is further ordered that petitioner-respondent's cross motion to dismiss the appeal is denied (M-2022-02882).
