The following e-filed documents, listed by NYSCEF document number (Motion 001) 15, 16, 17, 18, 19 were read on this motion to/for CONSOLIDATE/JOIN FOR TRIAL.

Upon the foregoing documents, it is ordered that defendants New York Wheel LLC and Gugan Rajaratnam’s motion to consolidate is granted. Defendants move to consolidate this personal injury action with two other actions (Kendra Vinson v New York Wheel, LLC and Rajaratnam, index no. 153700/18 and Kae-Shon Vinson v New York Wheel, LLC and “John” Rajaratnam, first name unknown, index no. 512585/18), one of which is currently pending in the Supreme Court, Kings County, arguing that the three actions arise out of the same accident and have common parties. CPLR §602(a) states that “[w]hen actions involving a common question of law or fact are pending before a court, the court, upon motion ... may order the actions consolidated”. No opposition has been filed. It is undisputed that the actions arise out of the same motor vehicle accident and involve many of the same parties. Thus, moving defendants’ motion to consolidate is granted to the extent that the two actions commenced by plaintiff Kendra Vinson shall be full consolidated, and the action commenced by plaintiff Kae-Shon Vinson shall be joined for discovery and trial, and shall maintain separate pleadings, captions, and index numbers, with separate certificates of readiness and notes of issue.

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that plaintiff's motion to consolidate is granted; and it is further

ORDERED that the caption of the consolidated action shall be the following:

and it is further

ORDERED that the action Kae-Shon Vinson v New York Wheel, LLC and "John" Rajaratnam, first name unknown, index no. 512585/18, pending in the Supreme Court, Kings County, shall be consolidated in this Court with Kendra Vinson v New York Wheel, LLC, Rajaratnam, T.M. Vinson-Holmes, and Tyrell Kaeshon Vinson, Index No. 153700/18, New York County; and it is further

ORDERED that a separate index number be given to the action Kae-Shon Vinson v New York Wheel, LLC and "John" Rajaratnam, first name unknown, being transferred from the Supreme Court, Kings County, to this Court upon payment of the appropriate fees, if any, and it is further

ORDERED that, within 30 days from entry of this order, counsel for the movant shall serve a certified copy of this order upon the Clerk of the Supreme Court, Kings County, and shall

pay the appropriate fee, if any, for such transfer and shall contact the staff of said Clerk to arrange for the effectuation of the transfer in an efficient manner; and it is further

ORDERED that service upon the Clerk of the Supreme Court, Kings County shall be made in accordance with any applicable protocol or other procedures of said county; and it is further

ORDERED that the Clerk of the Supreme Court, Kings County, shall transfer the documents on file under Index No. 512585/18 to the Clerk of this Court for the purpose of consolidation; and it is further

ORDERED that the Clerk of the Supreme Court, Kings County and the Clerk of this court shall coordinate the transfer of the documents being transferred so as to ensure an efficient transfer and to minimize insofar as practical the reproduction of such documents, including with regard to any documents that may be in digital format; and it is further

ORDERED that the pleadings in the actions hereby consolidated shall stand as the pleadings in the consolidated action; and it is further

ORDERED that, within 30 days from entry of this order, movant shall serve a copy of this order with notice of entry on the Clerk of the Court (60 Centre Street, Room 141 B), who shall consolidate the documents in the actions hereby consolidated and shall mark his records to reflect the consolidation for joint discovery and trial; and it is further

ORDERED that such service upon the Clerk of the Court shall be made in hard-copy format if the case pending in this county is a hard-copy case or, if this case is an e-filed one, shall be made in accordance with the procedures set forth in the *Protocol on Courthouse and County Clerk Procedures for Electronically Filed Cases* (accessible at the "E-Filing" page on this court's website at the address www.nycourts.gov/supctmanh); and it is further

ORDERED that, as applicable and insofar as is practical, the Clerk of this Court shall file the documents transferred from the Supreme Court, Kings County in the consolidated case file under the New York County Index Number of the consolidated action in the New York State Courts Electronic Filing System or make appropriate notations of such documents in the e-filing records of the court so as to ensure access to the documents in the consolidated action; and it is further

ORDERED that, within 30 days from entry of this order, movant shall serve a copy of this order with notice of entry upon the Clerk of the General Clerk's Office (60 Centre Street, Room 119), who is hereby directed to reflect the consolidation by appropriately marking the court's records; and it is further

ORDERED that discovery shall proceed expeditiously; and it is further

ORDERED that all parties, or counsel, shall appear in room 106 of 80 Centre Street, New York, NY on October 7, 2019 at 9:30am for a previously scheduled compliance conference.

This constitutes the Decision/Order of the Court.
