ORDERED that by February 18, 2022, each attorney shall serve a copy of this order with notice of entry upon the former client at their last known addresses by certified mail, return receipt requested, and upon the attorneys for all other parties appearing in this action by posting to the New York State Courts Electronic Filing System; and it is further

ORDERED that, together with the copy of this order with notice of entry served upon the former clients Bentley Rothschild Financial, LLC and Bentley Rothschild, moving counsel shall forward a notice directing the former client to appoint a substitute attorney by February 25, 2022. If so, the court will sever the issue and refer it to the Special Referee Clerk for assignment to a Special Referee to hear and report


ORDERED that no further proceedings may be taken against these former clients without leave of this court until February 24, 2022; and it is further
