

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE
CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE OF THE COURTS**

Pursuant to the authority vested in me, and with the advice and consent of the Administrative Board of the Courts, I hereby amend, effective immediately, section 205.66(a), of the Uniform Rules for the Family Court, relating to the conditions of suspended judgments and probation in Persons in Need of Supervision proceedings, to read as follows:

**Section 205.66. Terms and conditions of order in accordance with
section 755 or 757 of the Family Court Act (PINS)**

(a) An order suspending judgment in accordance with section [754] 755 of the Family Court Act shall be reasonably related to the adjudicated acts or omissions of the respondent and shall contain at least one of the following terms and conditions directing the respondent to:

* * *

(14) in a case in which respondent has been adjudicated for acts of willful, malicious, or unlawful damage to real or personal property maintained as a cemetery plot, grave, burial place or other place of internment of human remains, provide restitution by performing services for the maintenance and repair of such property; or

(15) comply with such other reasonable terms and conditions as the court shall determine to be necessary or appropriate to ameliorate the conduct which gave rise to the petition.
